### AUTUMN MIGRATION, 1906.

Flicker, September 15.  
Redstart, September 1, 3-5, 15.  
Brown Thrasher, September 15 (four), 17 (two).

### SPRING MIGRATION, 1907.

Flicker, April 17.  
Blue Jay, May 11.  
Song Sparrow, March 14 (three).  
Junco, March 14 (ten).  
Chipping Sparrow, April 26.  
White-throated Sparrow, May 11 (three), May 23.  
Fox Sparrow, March 14 (eleven).  
Towhee, May 11 (four).  
Ovenbird, April 26, May 8 and 11.  
Brown Thrasher, May 11, 13 and 23.  
White-breasted Nuthatch, May 11.  
Hermit Thrush, April 17 (four).  
Robin arrived March 14, remained all summer.  
Bluebird, March 20 (four).
