

A RARE NESTING RECORD OF THE WHITE-BREASTED NUTHATCH

On May 9, 1942, J. Fletcher Street showed Edward J. Reiman and me a nest of this species which he had located in a large pine woods near Riverton, Burlington County, N. J. The nest was in a small knot hole in a branch of an oak tree about 25 feet above the ground. Examination revealed 7 eggs.
