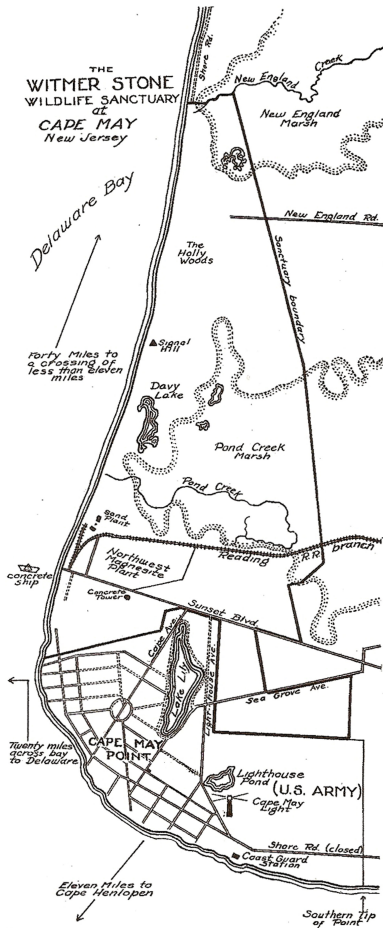


Support the Re-establishment of the Witmer Stone Wildlife Sanctuary in Cape May, New Jersey

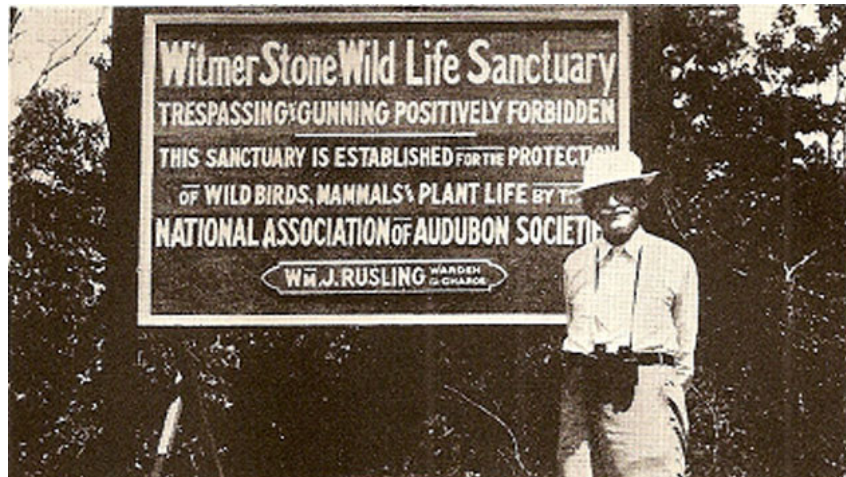
In 1935 the Witmer Stone Wildlife Sanctuary was established in Cape May, NJ. The map shows the original location of the sanctuary. This year the DVOC has sponsored an effort to re-establish this sanctuary. The Cape May Point State Park Superintendent has approved the placement of wayside educational signs. The state does not have the funding therefore we must raise the money for the signs. The goal is to raise \$10,000 to cover the cost of several signs. One, a facsimile of the original sign pictured below would identify the Sanctuary. The others would be educational wayside signs to inform visitors about Witmer Stone and his contributions to conservation. No donation is too small.
